Conservation

We actively support the work of NJOVU African Wildlife Conservation Organization, whose focus is on helping communities within key wildlife corridors coexist sustainably with wildlife. Their work includes human–wildlife conflict mitigation, community sensitisation, and snare sweep operations carried out alongside the Department of National Parks and Wildlife. Where appropriate, guests can engage in these field-based conservation activities, offering meaningful, impact-led safari add-ons that provide genuine insight into conservation on the ground.



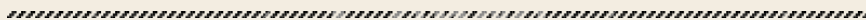
COMMUNITY
